

In the main programme

Teacher assessments showed that **80%** showed improvements in emotion behaviour and conduct behaviour. **77%** showed improvements in speaking, listening and learning. **81%** showed improvements back in class.

In the recovery programme

Teacher Assessments showed that **90%** showed improvements in emotion behaviour and conduct behaviour. **87%** showed improvements in speaking, listening and learning. **95%** showed improvements back in class.
